The collected representations illustrating a subject.

A set of specified or traditional symbolic forms associated with the subject  
or theme of a stylized work of art. A treatise or book dealing with iconography.

ma·nip·u·la·tion ( P ) Pronunciation Key (m-npy-lshn)

To work with one's hands. To manipulate the keyboard.  
The act or practice of manipulating one's work.

[French, from manipule, handful, as of grain, from Latin manipulus, sheaf, handful. ]

ma·nip·u·late ( P ) Pronunciation Key (m-npy-lt)  
tr.v. ma·nip·u·lat·ed, ma·nip·u·lat·ing, ma·nip·u·lates  
To move, arrange, operate, or control by the hands or by  
mechanical means, especially in a skillful manner.

[Back-formation from manipulation.]

Synonyms: manipulate, exploit, maneuver.

Of or relating to electrons.

Of, based on, operated by, or otherwise involving the controlled conduction of electrons or other charge carriers, especially in a vacuum, gas, or semiconducting material.

Of, relating to, or produced by means of electronics: electronic navigation; electronic books.

Of or relating to music produced or altered by electronic means, as by a tape recorder or synthesizer.

Of, implemented on, or controlled by a computer or computer network.

To conceive or fashion in the mind; invent: design a good excuse for not attending the conference.

To formulate a plan for; devise: designed a marketing strategy for the new product.

To plan out in systematic, usually graphic form: design a building; design a computer program.

To create or contrive for a particular purpose or effect: a game designed to appeal to all ages.

To have as a goal or purpose; intend.

To create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner.

To make or execute plans.

To have a goal or purpose in mind.

To create designs.

A drawing or sketch.

A graphic representation, especially a detailed plan for construction or manufacture.

The purposeful or inventive arrangement of parts or details: the aerodynamic design of an automobile; furniture of simple but elegant design.

The art or practice of designing or making designs.

Something designed, especially a decorative or an artistic work.

An ornamental pattern. See Synonyms at figure.

A basic scheme or pattern that affects and controls function or development: the overall design of an epic poem.

A plan; a project. See Synonyms at plan.

A reasoned purpose; an intent: It was her design to set up practice on her own as soon as she was qualified.

Deliberate intention: He became a photographer more by accident than by design.

A secretive plot or scheme. Often used in the plural: He has designs on my job.
